MINUTES

Chair Mollenhauer called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

Trustees Jensen and Stamp moved and seconded approval of the minutes from the meeting held on July 14, 2022, and directed them to be made a part of the permanent record. Motion carried: 9-0.

Trustees Wright and Williams moved and seconded approval of the August 11, 2022 agenda. Motion carried: 9-0.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

Kirkwood Report

Justin Hoehn, Director of Media and Legislative Relations, provided the Eagle Update and Kirkwood report, which included:

- The start of classes is August 22. Returning Kirkwood students are gearing up for the new academic year
 as well and new students will be taking classes on Kirkwood campuses for the first time. Kirkwood Student
 Life has activities scheduled for the first week of classes to help everyone to campus. The full schedule of
 events can be found at http://www.kirkwood.edu/events.
- The new student center has been under construction the last two years. The finishing touches are still being done and new student visits and orientations have begun in this new space. The staff have moved in and nearly ready to welcome everyone back to campus to begin another academic year. The new student center looks and feels incredible. The state-of-the-art building has everything today's student needs to feel at home and succeed in their academic career.
- Student of the month is Alice Tshibanda. She was born in Congo and moved to the U.S. with her family 10 years ago. Alice speaks four languages including English, French, Lingala, and Tshiluba (both languages are spoken in the Republic of Congo and the Democratic Republic of Congo). At Kirkwood, Alice is an interior design student and has been interested in architecture and construction. Over the summer, she interned at DLR group in Minneapolis, which is one of the top architecture firms in the country. In five years, Alice sees herself established in her career. She looks forward to further exploration of the interior design field, expanding her knowledge, and the experience of working on great design projects firsthand.
- The Nursing department has developed an agreement with Mercy Iowa City called the JumpStart Program. In their final semester, participating RN students will receive a stipend of up to \$5,000 while LPN students will be eligible to receive a maximum of \$3,000. Mercy will cover the cost of the student's Board of Nursing exam and licensure fees up to \$350. Once a student has graduated and received their license, they will have a guaranteed job at the hospital.
- Kirkwood's lowa City Writing Center is working with the lowa City and Coralville public libraries to relaunch the Community Writing Center. Interested community members will be able to receive one-on-one help with their writing from Kirkwood writing faculty two evenings each week. All types of writing will be welcome including resumes, applications, op-eds, reports, essays, legal documents as well as creative writing of all types.
- Kirkwood was recently featured in the Corridor Business Journal regarding the new Aviation Maintenance Technology Program. The article referenced workforce issues facing the field and how Kirkwood is well positioned to have a major impact in the industry-as well as what the future of the program holds.

• The Kirkwood Eagles athletics teams are preparing for their seasons. The volleyball team will start their 2022 campaign next week versus St. Louis Community College in Rockford, IL. The basketball season begins in November. Radio Station KMRY is the official radio partner of Kirkwood Athletics (93.1 on your FM dial and 1450 on the AM side).

Financial Report

Treasurer Choate provided an update on the audit, which will begin soon and the expected results for FY22 would remain approximately at \$9.2 million as previously discussed. The FY23 detailed operating budget was reviewed highlighting that credit hours were budgeted to be flat; however, the tuition increase was 7.5% to help offset the impacts of currently high inflation. Progress on personnel movement was highlighted within the budget with more efforts identified to be completed in the next year. Operating expenses are budgeted to increase 12.5% due to a return to pre-pandemic levels and high inflation. FY23 net income is a budgeted deficit of approximately \$1.7 million.

The college cash position remains strong at 148 days.
