Program Description

Surgical technologists are allied health professionals who are an integral part of the team of medical practitioners providing surgical care to patients in a variety of settings. They work under the supervision of a surgeon to ensure the operating room or environment is safe, that equipment functions properly, and that the operative procedure is conducted under conditions that maximize safety.

A surgical technologist possesses expertise in the theory and application of sterile and aseptic technique. They combine the knowledge of human anatomy, surgical procedures, and implementation of tools and technologies to facilitate a physician's performance of invasive, therapeutic, and diagnostic procedures.

This Allied Health program has a mandatory background check for clinical purposes.
