The U.S. Department of Education requires that we verify your selective service registration. Men aged 18–25 are required to register with the Selective Service System (SSS).

We must have documentation before we can continue processing your financial aid.

<input type="checkbox"/> I am a non-citizen who entered the U.S. after turning 26, → -OR- I entered the U.S. as a lawful non-immigrant, between the ages of 18 and 25, on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. when I turned 26 or older. <i>Please note: A Resident Alien Card (Green Card) is not valid proof of entry to the U.S.</i>	1. SUBMIT a copy of your birthdate from a birth certificate, passport, or driver's license/state ID, -AND- 2. SUBMIT documentation of immigration entry date into the U.S.: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ For entry after age 26 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Entry date stamp on I- 94 form; - OR - ○ Entry date stamp in passport - OR - ○ A letter from the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) indicating your entry date ▪ For proof of status in U.S. until you turned age 26 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A student visa form (I-20) - OR - ○ Other valid US passport visa stamp on a foreign passport with expiration date (the dates must be from entry until after the male turned 26)
<input type="checkbox"/> I am a male U.S. citizen, permanent resident alien, refugee, or political asylee, who did not register for selective service between the ages of 18 and 25 as required by law. → <i>Eligibility for aid will be determined by the financial aid office based on documentation submitted. Ignorance of the law is not excusable.</i>	1. SUBMIT a Status Information Letter from Selective Service - request a letter at www.sss.gov -AND- 2. SUBMIT a personal statement describing why you failed to register for selective service, including any extenuating circumstances and whether you knowingly or willfully failed to register as required by law. Please provide as much information as possible.
<input type="checkbox"/> I am currently in the armed services on active duty. SUBMIT a copy of your DD Form 214. Note: This does not apply to members of the Reserve and National Guard who are not on active duty.	<input type="checkbox"/> I am a citizen of the Federated States of Micronesia, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or the Republic of Palau. SUBMIT documentation of citizenship.
<input type="checkbox"/> I was born a female and am not required to register. SUBMIT birth certificate as documentation.	<input type="checkbox"/> I was born before 1960 and was not required to register. SUBMIT documentation of birthdate.
<input type="checkbox"/> Other; please explain in a personal statement and provide documentation of your circumstance.	<input type="checkbox"/> I was incarcerated, or hospitalized, or institutionalized for medical reasons and was released after age 26. SUBMIT documentation.
