Skilled Trades Day – Spring 2010

Students will spend the day touring different work sites and businesses in the Cedar Rapids area. Some examples of careers include carpentry, construction, electrical, masonry, plumbing and heating and air conditioning. You will also be given information about the various apprenticeship programs available.

Kirkwood Agricultural Science Day – March 30, 2010

If you are interested in a career in agricultural business, agricultural production, horse science or agricultural mechanic, you will want to attend this event. You will be able to visit with instructors and students to learn about the many career opportunities available in these careers and tour the Kirkwood facilities.

Kirkwood Horticulture Day – April 22, 2010

There are many careers in the area of horticulture – park ranger, conservationist, turf and golf course management, landscaping and floral design. You will visit with instructors and students to learn about these careers, see demonstrations of these careers and tour the Kirkwood facilities.

Students will tour engineering research labs on the University of Iowa campus and visit with faculty members and students from engineering fields including biomedical, chemical, electrical/computer, civil/environmental, mechanical and industrial engineering.
