Concurrent Enrollment

F1 visa students who have an I-20 issued by another school and are currently enrolled in another college or university in the US need permission to enroll at Kirkwood Community College. Follow this process to obtain approval by Kirkwood's International Student Advisor to enroll.

1. Submit Application for Admission to Kirkwood Online
 - Complete and submit online international student application form at <http://www.kirkwood.edu/international> .
 - Review Timeline for Admissions

2. Submit Documents to International Programs Office at Kirkwood.
 - a) A copy of your current form I-20
 - b) A copy of your visa and form I-94
 - c) Submit one of the following Proof of English Language Level:
 - A US college or university transcript or degree evaluation report showing courses and grades of work completed.
 - Test scores (If available, not required) TOEFL score of 500 PBT, 173 CBT, 63 IBT, IELTS score of 5.0 or higher, SAT score of 290 or higher and ACT of 15 or higher with English sub score of 15 or higher. If not available, you will be required to take the English Language Acquisition (ELA) examination prior to registration.

Consult with your International Student Advisor. The Advisor will ensure that you are maintaining your student visa status and also taking classes that meet requirements for your program.

Because you indicated that you intend to be a part-time F1 visa student, you must submit the documents listed above before you are cleared to register. If you have any questions, please call our office at 319-398-5579.
