Kirkwood Community College, in cooperation with Linn County Public Health (LCPH) will be holding an H1N1 vaccination clinic for high risk groups listed below. The H1N1 clinic will be held Tuesday, December 1<sup>st</sup>, & Wednesday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>, from 10a – 2p at Iowa Hall, Rm. 125.

This clinic will be by appointment **ONLY!** People that qualify for the H1N1 vaccine **must** call Campus Health at **398-5588** to schedule an appointment. Walk-ins will not be accepted.

Individuals that are in the following categories qualify for the clinics mentioned above.

- pregnant women,
- household contacts and caregivers for children younger than 6 months of age,
- health care and emergency medical services personnel,
- all people from 6 months through 24 years of age,
- persons aged 25 through 64 years who have health conditions associated with higher risk of medical complications from influenza.

The flu mist, and a **limited** supply of the injectable vaccine will be available. If you qualify for the flu mist, you will be required to accept this form of vaccine.
