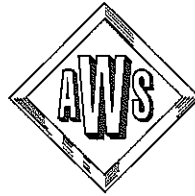

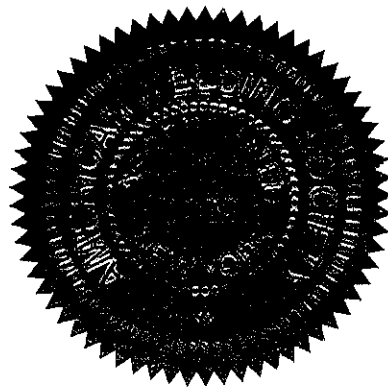

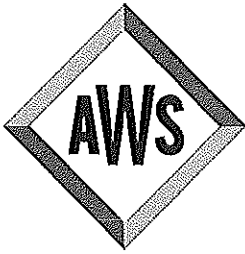

Please note the expiration date is *March 1, 2020* one year from the original date of issuance.


