Chair Pearson called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

Student Perspectives

Jennifer Bradley provided a brief update on the League for Innovation student competitions, sharing that Kirkwood had two national winners for 2024–2025. She then turned the introduction over to Dr. Lisa Angella, Professor of English and Faculty Editor of *The Cedar Valley Divide*, who recognized the two honorees. **Abdhi Hamisi**, a Visual Communication and Design student, received second place in the art competition for his photo "Freshman Year," which will appear in the catalog published by Santa Fe College this fall. **Noelle Diedrichs**, a Business Administration – Management student and Training and Development Specialist at GreenState Credit Union, earned first prize in the literary competition for her essay "The Day the World Should Have Stopped," which was published in *The Cedar Valley Divide* and will be included in the League's 2025 anthology.

Kirkwood Report

Justin Hoehn, Director of Media Relations and Communications, provided the Kirkwood report, which included:

- Jasmin Headley, a World Languages student taking American Sign Language classes at Kirkwood, has been names the September Student of the Month.
- Kirkwood has joined the Aspen Institute's Unlocking Opportunity Network, a national initiative focused on strengthening community college programs and advising to better support student success.
- Two impactful flag displays were held on main campus. The Kirkwood Active Minds chapter placed 1,100 white flags to represent the number of college students lost to suicide each year, while another display honored the 24th anniversary of the September 11 attacks.
- On September 4, our Nursing Department, Veterans Services, and TRIO staff took part in the Five Seasons Stand Down at Veterans Memorial Stadium, offering support and resources to veterans in need.
- Colette Atkins, Associate Vice President of Academic Affairs, has been selected for the 2025–26 Leadership Iowa program, sponsored by the Iowa Association of Business and Industry Foundation.

Financial Report

Treasurer Dunning provided a high-level review of the cash balance report. Typically, the months of July and August have seen decreases in cash balances due to less revenue being collected during these months, annual payments paid at the beginning of the new fiscal year, and reimbursements from fiscal year end not being received until September. As of August 2025, the College has 136 days of unrestricted cash reserves which exceeds the target of 90 days of unrestricted cash reserves.

Treasurer Dunning also provided a high-level overview of the College's ACE Infrastructure (260G) funds. The review included an overview of the program and an update on how the funds have been allocated over the previous three fiscal years.
