Per federal regulations, students who do not meet the independent student criteria are considered dependent students. Dependent students are required to report parent information on the FAFSA. Parents who provide their information on the FAFSA are **not** under any financial obligation for the student's educational expenses. This information is used solely to determine financial aid eligibility.

If parents refuse to give that information, students are automatically *ineligible* for:

- Pell Grants
- Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants
- Academic Competitiveness Grants
- Iowa Vocational Technical Grants
- lowa Grants
- Work-study
- Subsidized Direct Loans

The only federal or state financial aid a student can receive are unsubsidized Direct Loans. These loans accrue interest from the date of disbursement unlike the subsidized version, for which the federal government pays all interest while the student is enrolled at least half time.

The Kirkwood Financial Aid Office highly recommends parents provide the necessary information so the student can be considered for the best possible financial aid package.
