Understanding SAP

SAP Requirements

1. Stay in Good Academic Standing. = 2.0 Cumulative GPA

Students must meet or exceed a 2.0 GPA A=4.0 B=3.0 C=2.0 D=1.0 F=0.0

2. Successfully Finish the Classes You Start. = 67% Cumulative Pace Rate

Credits completed ÷ credits attempted must equal or exceed 67%. No classes completed first semester = Immediate Suspension.

3. Stay on Track to Graduate. = 150% Time Frame

Credits attempted ÷ credits required for program must be less than 150%.

SAP Statuses



SATISFACTORY

You meet all requirements and are eligible for aid.

TAKE ACTION

File an appeal

After your meeting with your academic advisor you will have access to a web-based appeal form at https://kirkwood.verifymyfafsa.com.

Appeals should only be completed if you have had an extenuating circumstance preventing you from meeting SAP requirements.

► SAP Appeal Outcomes

1. Approved

Aid will be reinstated. You will be on Academic Plan status until you meet SAP requirements or graduate. You will need to maintain a 75% Pace and a minimum 2.0 GPA each semester while on an academic plan.

2. Denied

Not eligible for aid. You may continue to be enrolled at Kirkwood, but you must pay tuition out of pocket until you are meeting the SAP standard.
